Supporting Milton-Freewater Student Mental-Behavioral Health Services

The Milton-Freewater Unified School District is excited to partner with the Rocks District Winegrowers with the goal of meeting the challenge of a critical need: expanding the delivery of mental-behavioral health services within the community-at-large. Currently, demand far exceeds capacity. Our community faces significant barriers to accessing care. Through this partnership, we see an opportunity to bridge this gap and bring more comprehensive mental health services to our students.

The current investments in mental health and nursing staff within our schools have already demonstrated positive results, but we need to do more. Providing these services on campus allows students to receive the help they need within minutes, rather than missing valuable instructional time to travel to appointments. Without access to local services, students with regular appointments are often marked as chronically absent, and in many cases, staff members must step in to provide transportation due to parents' work constraints.

Together our vision for a stronger, healthier community will enhance the well-being of our students and families. We believe that the success of The Basalt Bash & Barrel Auction will have a ripple effect, increasing access to services and improving the overall quality of life in Milton-Freewater.






Welcome to our first annual **Basalt Bash & Barrel Auction**.

Since this is the inaugural event... here's everything you need to know!

First of all – **We are inside**, out of the sun, in an air-conditioned space, so please dress comfortably. Regardless, it is late July in Walla Walla Valley...there will be summer heat outside.

Date - Saturday, July 26, 2025

Registration – Registration is accomplished via the Basalt Bash link on the www.rocksdistrict.com
Web site. All ticket sales are confirmed with a Cc, and all successful bids are charged at the conclusion of the Auction on



Location – The Barrel Tasting and Auction is hosted by Walla Walla Land Company at their Davis Orchards facility, 53293 Appleton Rd, Milton-Freewater, OR. Ample parking is available on site, but we encourage bus transportation (provided by Dream Ride Charters) from the Marcus Whitman Hotel parking lot in downtown Walla Walla to Davis Orchards and back, every half hour; beginning at 1:30 PM...with the last bus leaving Davis Orchards at 6:30 PM.

Cc and delivery address at check-in, thereby receiving a

Bid Number Button for bidding purposes.

Hours – Just a few steps away from the Tasting-Auction fun is the VIP Bubble Lounge, which serves as a prefunction and runs from 2-3 pm for no more than 50 Guests: early entry (beginning at 2:30 pm) into the Tasting-Auction is also provided with this VIP ticket.

Barrel Auction: What to Know

The Barrel Tasting & Auction doors open for general admission at 3 PM. All Auction bids close at 5:30 pm (credit cards will be charged once the Auction concludes...and the event concludes at 6 pm).

Check-in – Whether getting a little earlier start at the Bubble Lounge, or focusing on the Tasting & Auction main event, check-in (at each location) is where you will receive your **Bid Button**, an **Event Guide** and a tasting glass. Basalt Bash Volunteers will direct you to the appropriate venues once you arrive. If you purchased tickets for others, those folks will need to register for their own **Bid Button** at this time; providing a credit card number for charging at the Auction close.

Taste – Browse the hall first...taking in this one-of-a-kind Barrel Tasting opportunity. Use our Barrel Tasting Floor Map (p. 27) to help locate the water stations, food station, and Bid Assistance area. Then dive in...meet the owners and winemakers of these exclusive lots and collaborations crafted for The Bash.

Bid – Bid often for all of your new favorite wines via the Pouring Station QR codes. The Top 10 bids for each Lot will receive one case of wine each. The wines are still in barrel. Each producer is responsible for bottling the wine when it is ready. Shipping will be separately charged by each producer.

You will receive alerts as to your Top 10 positioning. Rebid often to ensure your winning positioning! Continue bidding until the 5:30 PM cut-off.

Silent Auction

- Bidding at the auction will be limited to registered parties of the presenting host (Rocks District Winegrowers - RDW) on behalf of The Basalt Bash and Barrel Auction (Basalt Bash). Bidders must be pre-registered; providing an email address, a wine case delivery address and a valid credit card.
- 2. All bids are final as of 5:30 PM on 7/26/2025. Winning bidders will be announced by 6 PM. Bids are recorded and administered via the Basalt Bash Auctria app (per LOT). All bids include the registered bid number, provided via the app. Winning bidders will be charged on their registered credit card. A receipt from Rocks District Winegrowers will be automatically generated and forwarded to each winning bidder's email address on file.
- 3. These terms and conditions of sale (unless amended by addendum) constitute the entire terms and conditions of the Seller with respect to the sale and purchase of wines sold at Auction to winning bidders. By bidding, the bidder agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions of sale.
- 4. All statements by Seller are merely statements of opinion and are not to be relied upon by prospective purchasers as warranties or representations of fact, and prospective bidders, by so bidding, acknowledge that they have inspected the wines to their satisfaction and bid only as a result of their own inspection and opinion. All wine is sold "as is."
- 5. Wines offered in this Auction will be sold as described. All Lots consist of ten total cases and are sold to bidders in one case increments. The highest ten bids of record for each Lot (once the bidding is closed) will be recorded as the successful case(s) purchaser(s) for that Lot. Bidders can bid multiple times to purchase more than one case of each lot. The producing winery retains sole discretion as to when the wine will be bottled and/or delivered to the purchaser; the purchaser acquires only the right to take possession of the wine when notified, and has no right of inspection pending notification. All Lots are sold FOB warehouse of the wine's producer. (Sold by Rocks District Winegrowers.) Shipping dates are established

Silent Auction Terms and Conditions

by each producer. Direct contact from the producer regarding shipping charges and taxes for each case will require a further credit card transaction (in this instance between purchaser and producer). The right to take possession shall not be assigned or otherwise transferred without first obtaining the written permission of Rocks District Winegrowers on behalf of the Basalt Bash and Barrel Auction.

- 6. Any offer of sale shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the state of Oregon. No sales tax is charged Oregon residents. Washington bonded producers will be governed by and abide the laws of the state of Washington.
- 7. Bids will be made on the purchase price for the total Lot of twelve (12) 750ml bottles (one case each).
- Starting bid dollars can be found on the Auction Lot page of the Web site: www.rocksdistrict.com (The Basalt Bash link embedded in the menu bar).
- 9. Bids will be accepted only from registered bidders.
- 10. Should a dispute arise between bidders, or should Rocks District Winegrowers (RDW) doubt the validity of any bid, RDW shall have the absolute right to resolve the dispute, re-offer, re-sell or withdraw the bid(s) from the bid-lot in question.
- 11. The ten highest acknowledged bidders shall be deemed to have purchased the case(s) within that Lot and thereupon assumes full risk and responsibility thereof. Purchaser warrants that he/she will pay the full bid purchase price as recorded at the auction. Seller's sole responsibility for non-delivery shall be limited to refund of the purchase price.
- 12. Bidding on-line, or in person, at the silent auction will be limited to registered bidders only. Register via www.rocksdistrict.com, following the link in the menu bar to **The Basalt Bash**.
- No representative or employee of Seller shall have the right to waive or modify any of the terms/conditions set forth herein.
- 14. You must be a registered bidder in order to have bids executed on your behalf. Please purchase your ticket and register for the Rocks District Winegrowers Basalt Bash at www.rocksdistrict.com; following The Basalt

Bash link in the menu bar to Tickets. Credit card information and a delivery address will be requested. For those unable to attend, but who wish to bid, you, too, must register.

15. Should any of the Top Ten Lot bids be the same dollar amount, the bidding order, as captured and administered on-line, takes precedence. Each bid position will include the bid number of the registered bidder.

Payment

Payment for each case(s) within the lot will be the sole responsibility of the registered bidder at the time of the sale. Should a group of two or more people bid together as a consortium and win the bid, it will be the responsibility of the registered bidder to collect funds from the members of his consortium and pay Rocks District Winegrowers under the terms set forth herein (the same registered bidder would be responsible for shipping and taxes to the shipping producer). Under no circumstances will Rocks District Winegrowers split an invoice for an auction lot in order to receive payment from more than one person for each case sold.

Payment for all purchases will be charged at the end of the silent auction via registered Credit Card; American Express, MasterCard, or Visa. An invoice is generated at the time and emailed to the bidder of record. Credit card payments are executed at the close of bidding, on the day of the silent auction. Invoices not paid in full at auction will accrue a finance charge of 1.5% per month (18% per annum) on any unpaid balances until paid in full. Buyer agrees to pay all reasonable attorney's fees and costs of collection associated with the collection of past due amounts. No Lot will be released without proof of payment in full.

Collection

Purchaser agrees to take delivery of the wines within sixty (60) days of notification by the producer, provided payment for the lot has been received in full by Rocks District Winegrowers. Shipping expenses, taxes and insurance are the sole responsibility of the purchaser and will be invoiced by the producer.

Delivery

All Lots are sold FOB the warehouse of the producer of the wine by Rocks District Winegrowers (Seller). Shipping expenses, taxes and insurance are the sole responsibility of the purchaser, as executed-invoiced by the Producer.

The purchaser of wine shall make arrangements with the producing winery for delivery.

Bidders agree that the sales and delivery of Rocks District Winegrower's (Basalt Bash) wines shall not affect the right's of the producing wineries to sell their own wines to any distributor of their choosing in bidder's state, or any other state, or the right's of Rocks District Winegrower's (Basalt Bash) to sell future Rocks District Winegrowers (Basalt Bash) wines to any purchaser in any state, and bidder agrees to take whatever steps are necessary to accomplish that including the relinquishment of any rights which purchaser may have under state or federal law.
